Autumn in the Highlands is a beautiful time of the year to visit; with spectacular views of gold's, yellows browns and greens in the foliage of the Cairngorms National Park it truly is a beautiful part of the world.

Today we make our way to Loch Ness where we will take a 1 hour sightseeing cruise around this Loch. You will be able to view Urquhart Castle and other fascinating scenery within this cruise and you might even get chance to see 'Nessie' the Loch Ness monster!

The Loch stretches up to 70 miles long and is the largest freshwater body of water in the whole of Scotland.

We will stop for lunch at the Clansman Hotel before we board for our 1 hour cruise around Loch Ness.

The Clansman Hotel offers panoramic views over Loch Ness and is a perfect location for lunch.

Day 4

Today we make our way to the beautiful town of Pitlochry where you will have free time to explore this town before we make our way home arriving back early evening.
